

**Dr Mary Ramsay**

Dr Mary Ramsay is a Head of the Immunisation, Hepatitis and Blood Safety Department at the National Infection Service in Public Health England. She has been responsible for and leading the national surveillance of vaccine preventable disease and hepatitis in England since 1994, including setting up surveillance of hepatitis C infection in the 1990s. The department maintains a broad research portfolio in the epidemiology, burden and prevention of hepatitis and provides expert support to public health policy in these areas.

Since April 2013, the department has taken over the implementation and planning of all national immunisation programmes in the NHS.
