Virginia qualified as a nurse in 1988 and went on to qualify as a District Nurse and worked as a District Nurse Team Leader in East London.

For the past 12 years of her nursing career Virginia has focused her work in Palliative Care - initially as a Hospital Macmillan CNS and currently in St Luke's Hospice as an Advanced Nurse

Practitioner.

Virginia received the Jill Rutter Award for her work on Assisted Dying. In 2016 Virginia won the Hospice UK 'Innovation in Care' award for her work on Advanced Liver Disease. She has recently co-led the Shared Care Liver Project, which has piloted the effectiveness of a parallel planning approach between hepatology and palliative care for patients with Advanced Liver Disease.

Virginia is currently working on transferring the shared care model to other non-malignant groups.
