Currently Clinical Lead for the Liver Unit, Lead for Paediatric Hepato-biliary and Transplantation and Clinical Director Cardiac, Transplant and GI and Associate Chief Medical Officer for international Doctors Birmingham Children's Hospital, United Kingdom.

Along with other contribution to health care improvement in Pakistan, set-up a Liver transplant centre at a Military Hospital in Pakistan and was awarded Pride of Performance ( highest Civilian award) by the President of Pakistan in recognition of services.
