Professor Iqbal is a full time NHS gastroenterologist based in Birmingham. He has an interest in the gut microbiome. He is Chief Investigator of the STOP-COLITIS study which will be the largest trial of FMT once completed. He has good insight into the regulatory aspects of FMT both for clinical service and in the context of clinical trials having just gone through the process of

getting an MHRA licence. His group have the largest experience of treating *C.difficile* colitis with FMT in the UK. He is Chair of the UK Gut Microbiome for Health Expert Panel
