Parthi Srinivasan was born and educated in India. He obtained his medical qualifications from the Madras Medical College, University of Madras in 1989. He was then trained in General Surgery in the Republic of Ireland and United Kingdom respectively.

Parthi was awarded the Inter-Collegiate Fellowship (FRCS-Gen Surg) with sub speciality interest in Transplantation by the Royal College of Surgeons in 2003 after successfully passing the Inter-Collegiate exit examination held by the Royal Colleges of the United Kingdom and was entered into the list of Specialist Surgeons held by the General Medical Council of the United Kingdom.

In 2006 he was appointed to the prestigious post of Consultant Surgeon in the field of Liver Transplantation, Hepatobiliary and Pancreatic Surgery in King's College Hospital, London.

Parthi has performed in excess of 700 Liver Transplant operations as well as over 1000 complex liver and pancreatic resections. In addition, he has performed a large number of major laparoscopic procedures including liver resections and distal pancreatic resections. His clinical research interests include islet cell transplantation and he has helped to develop a successful program at King's.

His main interests include Liver Transplantation and Transplantation from Living Donors, Surgery for Malignant Diseases of the Liver, Biliary Tract and Pancreas and the application of modern techniques such as Laparoscopic Surgery in the management of patients with Hepato-Pancreato-Biliary diseases.
